Garden Judging

1. The judging of all nominated classes will commence on April 16, 2023 and concludes on April 29, 2023 with weather permitting.
2. The judging team may arrive at an entrant's property on any dates during the judging dates. The Promoter will endeavour to contact each entrant with a date for judging and an approximate time (either morning or afternoon), however, an exact time cannot be provided.
3. Allowing access to the entrant's property for judging purposes is a mandatory requirement of the competition.
4. Judging of the nominated gardens will be based on a point system with a set Criteria by a horticultural expert.
